



CANOPY CARE CHECKLIST

A SIMPLE GUIDE TO KEEPING YOUR CANOPY
LOOKING AND PERFORMING AT ITS BEST

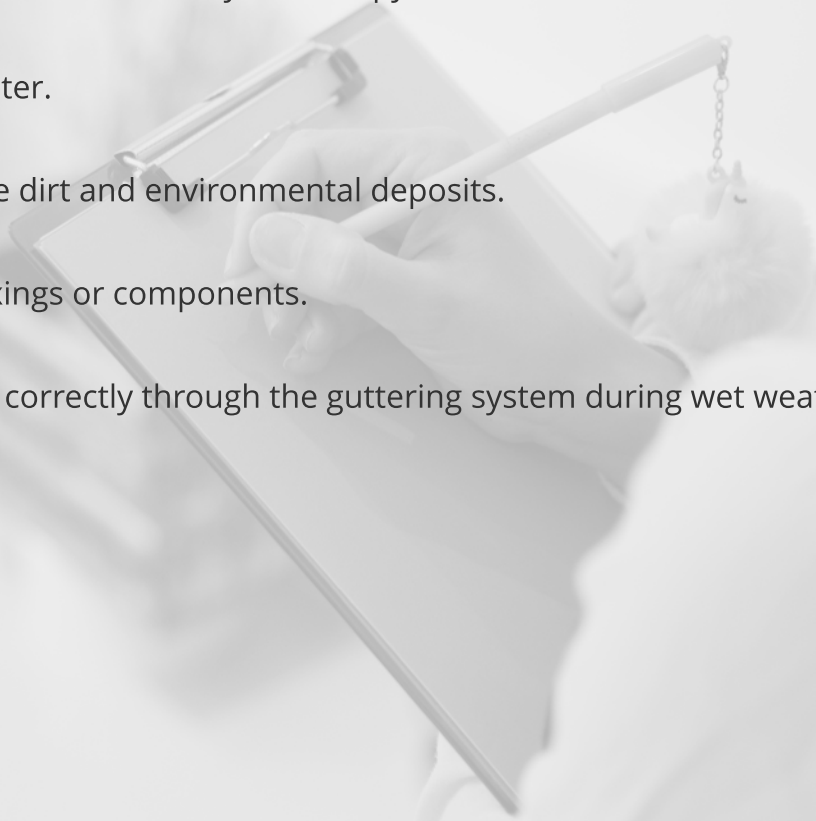
Monthly Checks

- ☐ Remove leaves, twigs and other debris from the canopy roof where safely accessible.
- ☐ Check that gutters and downpipes are clear and rainwater can drain away freely.
- ☐ Visually inspect the canopy for any obvious signs of accidental damage.



Every Three to Six Months

- ☐ Wash the roof panels using warm water, a mild soap solution and a soft cloth or sponge.
Never use bleach, solvents, abrasive paste, cream cleaners pressure washers or steam cleaners as they could damage the surface of your canopy.
- ☐ Rinse thoroughly with clean water.
- ☐ Clean the framework to remove dirt and environmental deposits.
- ☐ Inspect the canopy for loose fixings or components.
- ☐ Check that rainwater is flowing correctly through the guttering system during wet weather.



Severe Weather Canopy Care

A build up of heavy snow can put excess strain on the canopy. It is therefore advisable to:

- ☐ Ensure snow is cleared regularly from the roof of your canopy using a long handled broom. This will easily release any snow or ice buildup and prevent ice forming on the roof.

Following periods of high winds, storms or heavy snowfall, carry out a visual inspection.

Check for:

- ☐ Damaged roof panels
- ☐ Loose or displaced components
- ☐ Blocked guttering caused by storm debris
- ☐ Fallen branches or objects resting against the canopy

Seasonal Maintenance Guide

Spring

- ✓ Wash away winter dirt and debris.
- ✓ Inspect the canopy after winter weather.
- ✓ Check guttering and drainage.

Summer

- ✓ Clean roof panels to maximise natural light.
- ✓ Inspect for accidental impact damage.
- ✓ Remove any bird droppings promptly.

Autumn

- ✓ Clear fallen leaves regularly.
- ✓ Keep gutters and downpipes free-flowing.
- ✓ Trim back overhanging branches where appropriate.

Winter

- ✓ Visually inspect the canopy after storms or heavy snowfall.
- ✓ Check drainage remains unobstructed.
- ✓ Contact Able Canopies if you have any concerns.

Regular visual inspections and routine cleaning can help maximise the lifespan of your canopy while ensuring it continues to provide safe, reliable shelter throughout the year.
